

**Legal Proceedings of the City of Fox Lake  
Common Council  
May 20, 2020**

A special meeting of the City of Fox Lake Common Council was held on Wednesday, May 20, 2020, at 6:30 p.m., in the community center, to insure social distancing. The meeting was called to order by Mayor Tom Bednarek and was followed by the pledge of allegiance. Roll call was taken with alderpersons John Mund, Dan Ault, Dennis Linke, Peter Hartzheim, Robert Jenswold and Don Zilewicz present. Also attending were city attorney Mike Devitt, city administrator Dean Perlick, police chief Jim Rohr, librarian Erin Anders, and clerk Susan Hollnagel.

In the audience were Marcy Benz and Jenny Quirk.

The clerk certified open meeting laws have been complied with.

**Approve minutes**

Motion by Mund, seconded by Linke to approve the minutes of the May 6, 2020 council meeting as typewritten. Motion carried with a voice vote.

**Operator fees 2020-2021**

Motion by Mund, seconded by Ault to waive operator license fees for the 2020/2021 license period. Vote in favor: Mund, Ault, Linke, Hartzheim, Jenswold and Zilewicz. Motion carried.

**Resolution 2-2020 fund COVID-19 business support program**

Motion by Mund, seconded by Hartzheim to approve resolution 2-2020 to fund the City of Fox Lake COVID-19 Business Support Program, by providing a \$50,000- loan from the city's general outlay account to TID #2 to provide economic support to those businesses suffering from economic hardship due to the COVID-19 related business closures. The Mayor said he had spoke with Perlick and Perlick and Mary Perkins, from the Redevelopment Authority, will be reviewing the grant applications. He said they will also check to see if there are any arrears, due to the city, and will take it off the top. Perlick said they would be looking at unpaid water/sewer bills, personal property taxes, etc. Devitt said the city's application is following what most other government programs are doing. He said paying utility bills (water, sewer, light, gas) would be an appropriate use of the grant funds. The Mayor asked Devitt if they could take any unpaid bills off the top of the loan amount. Devitt said as long as the applicants are made aware of what you are doing, it should be okay. Vote in favor: Ault, Linke, Hartzheim, Jenswold, Zilewicz and Mund. Motion carried.

With no other business to come before the Council, motion by Linke, seconded by Mund to adjourned and go into committee of the whole. Motion carried with a voice vote. Meeting adjourned at 6:35 p.m.
