

**Legal Proceedings of the City of Fox Lake
Common Council
Aug 5, 2020**

The regular meeting of the City of Fox Lake Common Council was held on Wednesday, Aug 5, 2020, at 6:30 p.m., in the community center. The meeting was called to order by Mayor Tom Bednarek and followed by the pledge of allegiance. Roll call was taken with alderpersons John Mund, Dan Ault, Dennis Linke, Peter Hartzheim and Don Zilewicz present. Absent was Robert Jenswold. Also attending were City Police Chief Jim Rohr and City Clerk Jenny Quirk.

In the audience was Marcy Benz. There were no public comments.

Approve minutes

Motion by Mund, seconded by Ault to approve the minutes of the July 15, 2020 special council meeting, as typewritten. Motion carried with a voice vote.

Payment of bills

Motion by Linke, seconded by Mund to approve paying the bills, as audited, for accounts payable check #40867 through #40993, totaling \$208,790.95 (including ACH withdrawals) and payroll checks #59744 through #59814 totaling \$64,602.50. Vote in favor: Ault, Linke, Hartzheim, Zilewicz and Mund. Motion carried.

Licenses and Permits

Motion by Mund, seconded by Linke to approve the application for the keeping or maintaining of chickens for David Beske at 302 Wells St. Motion carried with a voice vote.

Consideration-Action

The Mayor read, as noted in the June 2, 2020 Fox Lake Public Library board minutes, "To move \$5,480.80 from the Library Material budget to the Maintenance budget to pay for the furnace."

Discussion regarding the annual dog swim at the Fox Lake Aquatic Center included a fee of \$5/dog to be charged at the door with verification of current vaccinations. With no lifeguards on duty the Fox Lake EMS will volunteer to stand by at the event. Marcy Benz said she would volunteer to work at the annual dog swim. A sign will be posted for patrons to wear masks.

Motion by Ault, seconded by Linke to hold the annual dog swim on Sunday Aug 23, 2020 from 4:00 – 7:00 pm at the Fox Lake Aquatic Center. Motion carried with a voice vote.
